

It is a program sponsored by the Missions Ministry Team to generate financial support for new church building projects from participating Cumberland Presbyterians. The Builders Fellowship program has been a vital part of the Cumberland Presbyterian expansion over the past decades.

Who is Builders Fellowship for?

Builders Fellowship is designed to assist new churches with its first building. It is available to all Cumberland Presbyterians.

How often does a member give and how much?

A member of Builders Fellowship commits to making a financial donation to new church building projects to pray for each new work. Missions Ministry Team sends up to 3 Builders Fellowship calls each year, designated for particular church building projects. The covenant with Builders Fellowship suggests a commitment of \$50.00 for each call.

What if I am not able to give to each Builders Fellowship call?

A member's circumstance may not permit participation at a particular time. One gives as she/he is able to give. If it appears you cannot continue in Builders Fellowship, please notify Missions Ministry Team and you will be removed from the mailing list.

How can I make a payment?

Builders Fellowship members can pay by Credit Card online at www.ministrycouncil.cumberland. org/buildersfellowship, just follow the instructions on our website. If paying by check, please make check payable to Missions Ministry Team and indicate it is for "Builders Fellowship." What is the typical total for a Builders Fellowship call?

Historically, the typical proceeds for a project have ranged from \$15,000.00 to \$25,000.00. A new church can receive as much as two calls.

What is the duration of the covenant for membership in Builders Fellowship?

Membership is open-ended. We have Builders Fellowship members who have been actively involved since the beginning of the program in the late 1970's. A member may discontinue the covenant at any time.

Can a church, youth group, Sunday School class or CP Women's Ministry group participate?

Any church or church group can become a member of Builders Fellowship.
